**Ephesians 1-3 - This is your identity, it's who you are as a Christian**

**Ephesians 4-6 - This is how you live in light of who you are**

**Ephesians 4:1** - Therefore I, a prisoner for serving the Lord, beg you to lead a life worthy of your calling, for you have been called by God. 2 Always be humble and gentle. Be patient with each other, making allowance for each other's faults because of your love. 3 Make every effort to keep yourselves united in the Spirit, binding yourselves together with peace. 4 For there is one body and one Spirit, just as you have been called to one glorious hope for the future.

5 There is one Lord, one faith, one baptism,

6 one God and Father of all, who is over all, in all, and living through all.

7 However, he has given each one of us a special gift<sup>[a]</sup> through the generosity of Christ. 8 That is why the Scriptures say,

“When he ascended to the heights, he led a crowd of captives and gave gifts to his people.”<sup>[b]</sup>

9 Notice that it says “he ascended.” This clearly means that Christ also descended to our lowly world.<sup>[c]</sup>

10 And the same one who descended is the one who ascended higher than all the heavens, so that he might fill the entire universe with himself.

11 Now these are the gifts Christ gave to the church: the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, and the pastors and teachers. 12 Their responsibility is to equip God's people to do his work and build up the church, the body of Christ. 13 This will continue until we all come to such unity in our faith and knowledge of God's Son that we will be mature in the Lord, measuring up to the full and complete standard of Christ.

14 Then we will no longer be immature like children. We won't be tossed and blown about by every wind of new teaching. We will not be influenced when people try to trick us with lies so clever they sound like the truth. 15 Instead, we will speak the truth in love, growing in every way more and more like Christ, who is the head of his body, the church. 16 He makes the whole body fit together perfectly. As each part does its own special work, it helps the other parts grow, so that the whole body is healthy and growing and full of love.

Ephesians 4:1-2 “Wherefore I, a prisoner for serving the Lord, beg you to lead a life worthy of your calling, for you have been called by God. 2 Always be humble and gentle. Be patient with each other, making allowance for each other’s faults because of your love.”

Vs. 1

- Worthy - Having a Worth that matches the actual value
- Leading - “Walking” Living life out loud, fully, not partially. Walking in a full circle not just part and getting tired and stopping.
- Live your life fully, in such a way it reflects the full value of God’s calling, His naming of you, his stamp of ownership, his adoption.

Paul, to you, “I implore you to live like you were called...because you were.

Church -- You were called, for such a time as this.

Esther 4:13-14 “Who knows if perhaps you were made queen for such a time as this?”

Because of who you are, God has positioned you:

- To influence
- To stand up
- To be seen
- To give all
  - To give your life.
  - Romans 5:8 “But God showed (demonstrated) his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners.”
  - He loves us and he showed that love.

Vs. 2

- Humility opens the door for gentleness and patience.
  - Humility - A realization of who I am without Christ. An end of self worship. Putting aside me-ism in pride, attitudes, opinions.
  - Humility is more of a mindset while gentleness and patience are both actions born from Humility.

- Gentleness - Acting without harshness. Seen best in handling something fragile.
  - Slow down
  - Soft Impact
    - Without gentleness we break things.
  
- Patience - Acting without agitations and frustration. Seen best when engaging with something or someone who is slower than we want.
  - Slow Down
    - Without patience we break things.
  
- Test your Humility, Gentleness and Patience in stressful situations.

Sap - The life blood of a tree under tremendous pressure and very sticky. When the tree is cut it “bleeds” sap that sticks to whatever touches it.

When you are cut do you bleed Humility, Gentleness and Patience?

Do people walk away from you with the “sap” of Humility, Gentleness and Patience still on their hands?

Lead a life worthy of the calling you have received by demonstrating love, bleeding and sticking to others in Humility, which opens the door for Gentleness and Patience.

Spend some time reading through Ephesians 1-3 and write down a list of truths about who you are. Then for each truth, you have written, write about a creative way this truth can be brought to life through action.
