## Sermon:

Scripture Reference: **John 11**

---

We are privileged to look at Easter through the lens of this side of history. The disciples looked at that weekend of events very differently and from a drastically different perspective.

The first half of John deals with the first 33 years of Jesus' life. The second half of John deals with the final week of Jesus' life.

**Chapter 11** is the \_\_\_\_\_ of the book of John.

**Verse 4** - "Lazarus' sickness will not end in \_\_\_\_\_. This has happened for the Glory of God..."

- Your \_\_\_\_\_ will not end in death.

**Verse 5-6** - "...although *Jesus* \_\_\_\_\_ Martha, Mary, and Lazarus he \_\_\_\_\_ where he was, *it wasn't the right time....*"

- His \_\_\_\_\_ in his answers to prayer are more important than immediate answers right when we are asking.

**Verse 21-24 and Mark 9:24** - "I do \_\_\_\_\_, but help me overcome my \_\_\_\_\_!"

- Offer Jesus the belief you have and ask him to add to it. He will honor this honesty and strengthen your faith.

**Verse 25** "I am the resurrection and the life. Anyone who believes in me will live, even \_\_\_\_\_ dying."

- **John 14:6** "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." Not only is Jesus saying that he is the way, but then he showed that he is the way by going to the Cross and giving his life to purchase our freedom from sin.

**Verse 33 - 39** "...when he saw the wailing a deep \_\_\_\_\_ welled up within him...he was deeply troubled...Jesus wept...he was still \_\_\_\_\_ when he arrived at the tomb..."

- Jesus was lamenting the brutality of sin on the earth and the heartbreak and relational separation it causes. "The enemy comes to steal, kill and destroy..."
- He was angry because the enemy is a thief who steals our hope, security, peace, purity, righteousness and relationships.

**Verse 40** "...didn't I tell you that you would see God's glory if you believe..."  
"I will \_\_\_\_\_ for you."

- Even when our belief (Faith) is weak, Jesus will work miracles in our lives, at the right time and for God's glory.

**Verse 43** "Lazarus, Come out!"

- Come forth!
- Exit the tomb!
- Leave behind what was and enter into what is. Leave death behind and enter into Life.

This is the Turning Point of the Gospel of John as Jesus would turn his eyes upon Jerusalem and the cross where he would breath his last. He was appointed for a purpose and anointed to fulfill that purpose. Then he would crest the hill and look into Jerusalem and weep once again as the celebrating masses spread out a "red carpet" before him with palm branches.

Jesus went to the tomb and then stepped out of the tomb so you can live free. So you could step out of your tomb.

That place that you are in.

That memory that holds you down.

That fear that binds you.

That hurt that continues to oppress you.

That disappointment that grates on you.

That \_\_\_\_\_ that holds you down in a tomb.

Jesus is the resurrection and the life. He has come to set you free.

**Be free indeed. Walk out of that tomb!**
